Les Dentelles du Cygne Côtes du Rhône Rosé 2014

Blend: secret

Area, age and yield of the vineyard : 2 hectares, 40 hl /ha, 30 years.

Terroir : BUISSON

The family vineyard is located on the north-facing slope of the Rasteau and Cairanne hillside, at an altitude of 180 to 250 metres, with north-east/north-west exposure.

These very complex soils are composed of clay and limestone earth covered by pebbles of marine and alluvial origin.

The natural vegetation contributes to the aromatic complexity of the wines: Aleppo pine, white oak, viburnum, boxwood, rosemary, dogwood, thyme...

Aromas and serving temperature :

Our Rosé combines sweetness of Mediterranean wine and fresques of our terroirs with north exposure.

Aromas of citrus and exotic fruits.

To be served as an aperitif, or with summery salads, pizzas, grilled meats and fishes like red mullet

Serve at 9° C.

Cultivation:

Biodynamics cultivation : in order to give emphases to respect for nature, our vineyards are maintained by regular tilling and by using natural treatments , with no synthetic products, thus maximising the full expression of the terroir.

Vinification and ageing :

Alliance of rosé de saignée (bled wines) and direct pressing.

Bottled after six months ageing in concrete vats.
